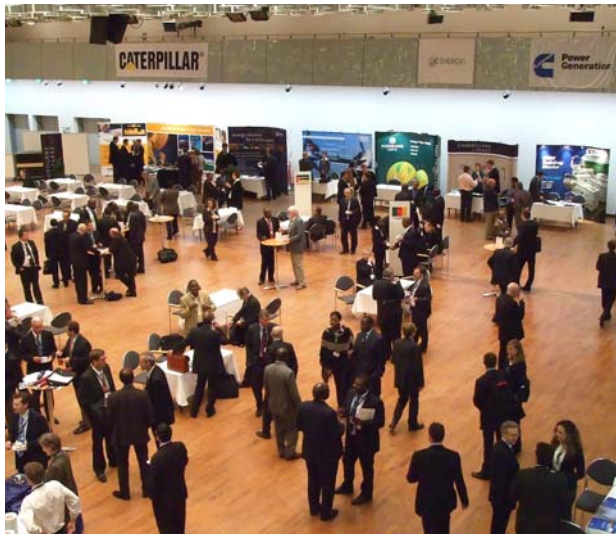
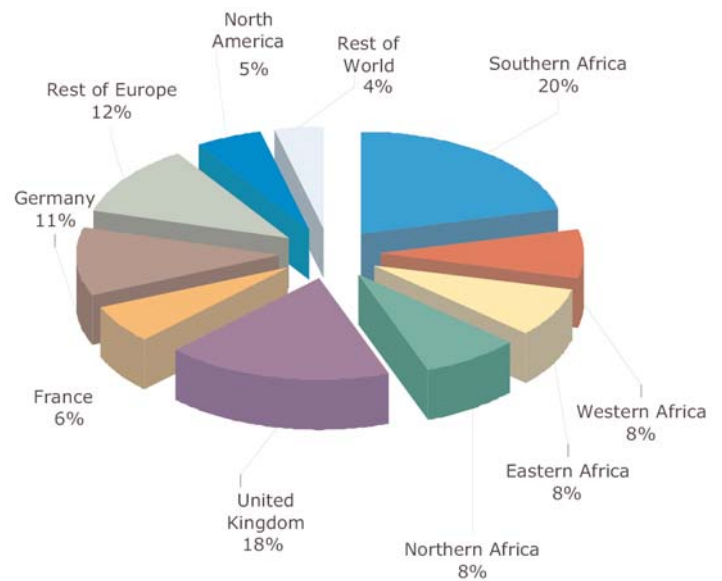

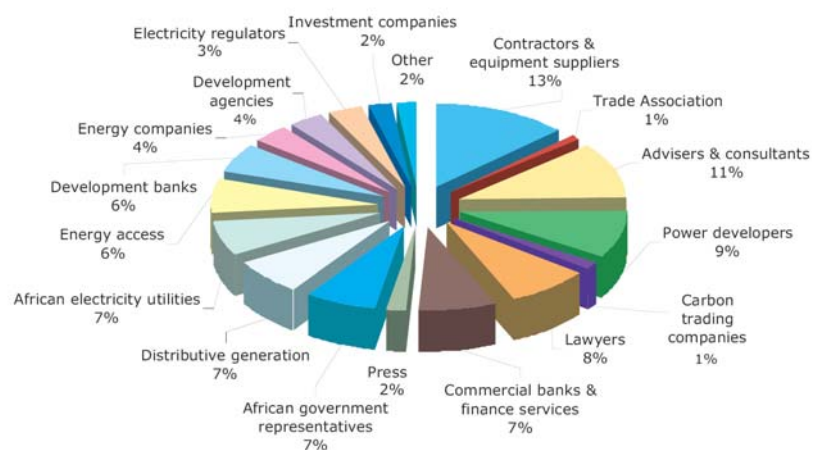


Reasons to Exhibit
